5. _____ To discuss matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or rules or state statutes.
6. _____ To discuss specialized details of security arrangements.
7. _____ To discuss confidential information related to marketing plans, specific business strategy, a production techniques, trade secrets or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance or to negotiations with other political subdivision regarding requests for economic development assistance.
