K-6 Learning Information:

- Any student choosing the Online Learning Option will remain a Bethel student.
- The Online Learning Option will be operated through a collaboration with the following agencies: Miami County and Montgomery County ESC.
- The online instructor would not be a Bethel staff member.
- Coursework is aligned with Ohio Department of Education standards.
- Students will be required to enroll in 5 courses (Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies and an Elective).
- Students will be expected to complete coursework daily. Consistent participation is required.
- Families must commit for a semester and cannot switch to traditional option during a semester.
- Students may participate in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities on campus.
- Students must complete all required statewide assessments.
- Grades will be calculated in GPA the same as traditional in person classes.

Bethel MS/HS will operate their online learning platform.

- Coursework is aligned with Ohio Department of Education standards.
- Students will be required to enroll in a minimum of 5-6 courses depending on grade level. Students must maintain five (5) full credits to be eligible for extra-curricular.
- Students will be expected to complete coursework daily. Consistent participation is required.
- Families must commit for a semester and cannot switch to traditional option during a semester.
- Students may participate in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities on campus.
- Students will have access to school counseling services as needed.
- The district will not offer online CCP courses through the online learning option. If interested in CCP courses, they must be taken through the student's chosen university or learning institution. AP courses will not be offered as well.
- Students must complete all required statewide assessments.

- Grades will be calculated in GPA the same as traditional in person classes.
