**The YMCA of Greater Dayton is a local partner in your community working to make collective impact. The YMCA has been serving the greater Miami Valley since 1858. The YMCA focuses on Youth Development, Healthy Living & Social Responsibility.**

Today, The YMCA of Greater Dayton has 11 locations throughout the Miami Valley and serves over 180,000 kids and families annually. Branches include the Coffman YMCA (Springboro), Downtown YMCA (Dayton), Fairborn YMCA, **Huber Heights YMCA**, Kleptz YMCA (Englewood), Preble County YMCA (Eaton), South YMCA (Kettering), West Carrollton YMCA, Xenia YMCA, YMCA Neighborhood Development Center Trotwood, and YMCA Camp Kern.



# GOAL: LEARN. GROW. THRIVE

The Y's Before and After School Care Program's primary focus is to provide a safe and nurturing environment that can provide children social emotional growth opportunities and parents a piece of mind knowing that surrounding their child's academic day they will take part in a multitude of enrichment activities to keep them positively engaged. The YMCA also stays flexible to meet the ever changing needs of our community and our families.

The YMCA uses a curriculum that intentionally fosters holistic youth development through a range of activities focused on helping youth achieve, build relationships and feel like they belong.

Childcare Staff receive a minimum of 36 hours of Ohio Professional Development. State Training, CPR/First Aid, Communicable Disease, Child Abuse Recognition and ongoing training to meet the children and program needs.

# **PROGRAM...BASED ON Y AFTERSCHOOL MODEL THAT INCORPORATES 9 COMPONENTS (DOSAGE IS FLEXIBLE)**

- \*21<sup>st</sup> century skills-project based learning
- \*Arts-projects that allow for planning, implementation & discussion
- \*College & Career Readiness-activities that allow for career exploration such as career club, bring in speakers/presenters
- \*Family & Parent Engagement-many events such as Healthy Kids Day, Safety Around Water, 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> grades free summer memberships, talent shows, etc
- \*Global Learning & Inclusion-cultural events & projects explore diverse perspectives
- \* Health & Wellness (Wellness & Nutrition + Physical Activity)- Nutrition Education, Indoor/Outdoor Activity, CATCH
- \* Academic Enrichment (Homework Help + Math/Literacy)
- \* Leadership Development-participants help with activity choice/plan
- \* Service Learning-projects which allow for engagement at the schools

- Dismissal until 6pm
- Note: YMCA will offer care for delay and early release days.

# TYPICAL DAY

## SAMPLE Before Care Schedule

- 630-9:10am Activity Centers
- 9:10am Release to Classrooms

## SAMPLE After Care Schedule

3:40-4:05pm Arrival/Check In/Wash Hands

4:05pm-5:00pm Snacks/Activity Centers/Homework Assistance

5:00-5:30pm Outside Time

5:30-6:00pm Slow down/Quiet Activities/Reading/Board Games/Additional Homework assistance

Activity Centers allow for activity choice and rotation of the program components.



## FEE OPTIONS

- Before Care Only - \$50.00 weekly
- After Care Only - \$50.00 weekly
- BOTH Before and After Care - \$90.00 weekly
- Break weeks \$140.00
- Non-school day add on \$20.00 in addition to the weekly fee
- YMCA Members receive a discount on weekly fees
- Public Funds Subsidy (Title XX) is accepted.
- Families who do not qualify for public funds may request assistance through the YMCA Annual Scholarship Campaign.

# I NEED RELIABLE CHILDCARE! WHEN IS THE YMCA OPEN? DO I NEED TO BE REGISTERED?

- THE YMCA will offer care in schools when school is open. We will follow the school calendar.
- The YMCA will offer care in schools when a professional development day occurs.
- The YMCA will offer care in schools when a delay occurs.
- The YMCA will offer calamity care at Huber Heights YMCA when school is cancelled. Closing after start of day - Transportation from your local school is the responsibility of the parent.  
Note: Y staff need to transition to alternate location
- Parents will be asked to sign up on sign up genius in advance to reserve calamity care day and non-school days
- The YMCA will offer additional pre-planned schools out/vacation days. They will be reservation in advance & added fee required.
