 - self-harming behaviors
 - interpersonal conflicts with peers
 - desire for independence
 - anxiety disorders
 - eating disorders
 - learning disorders
 - grief and loss/trauma
 - suicide
 - sexual identity development
- ❖ responsible to train and consult with educators and administrators on identifying student's issues and needs

- ❖ Provides counsel and coaching to help students manage stress, redirect disturbing emotions and set goals to build self-esteem
- ❖ Does not replace the academic counselors within the school but partner with them to assist positive student development.

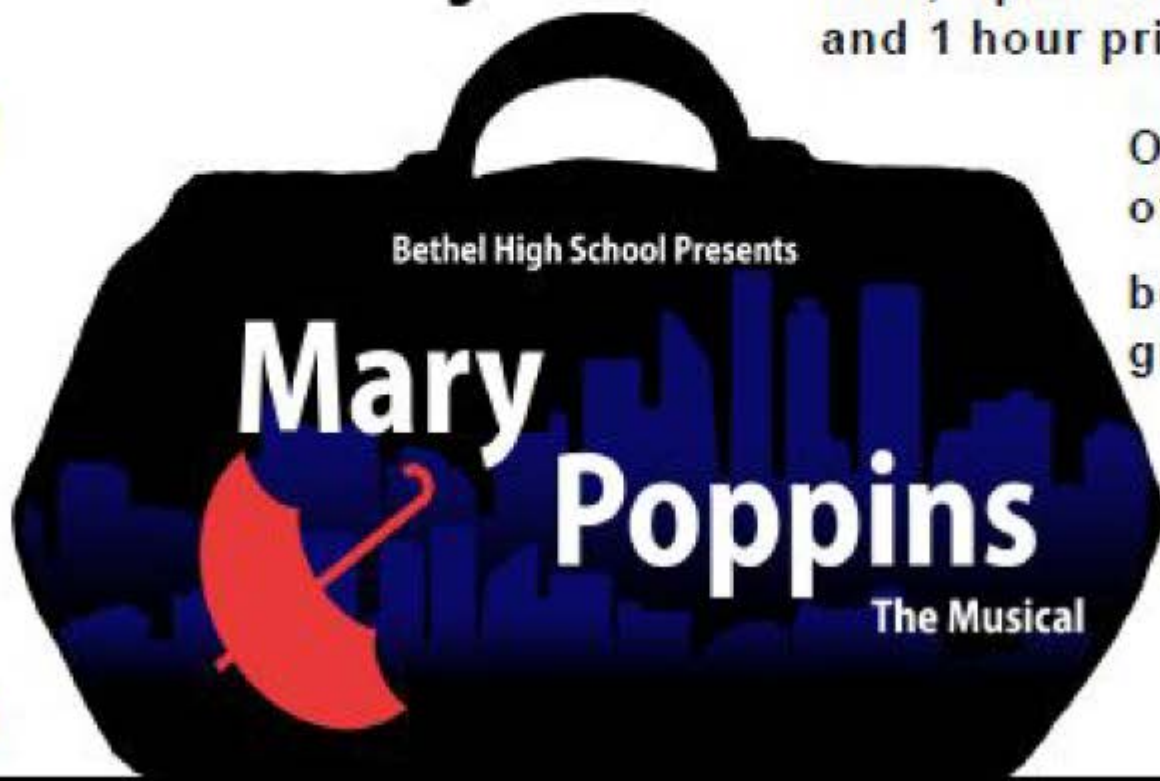
