Wednesday, Oct. 25th Grade 3 State Reading Test (AM and PM test sessions)

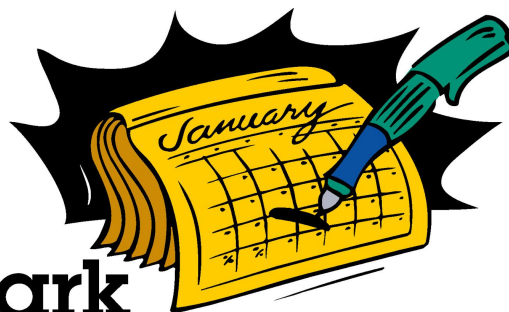
