Announcing Libraries Rock, our 2018 Summer Reading Club

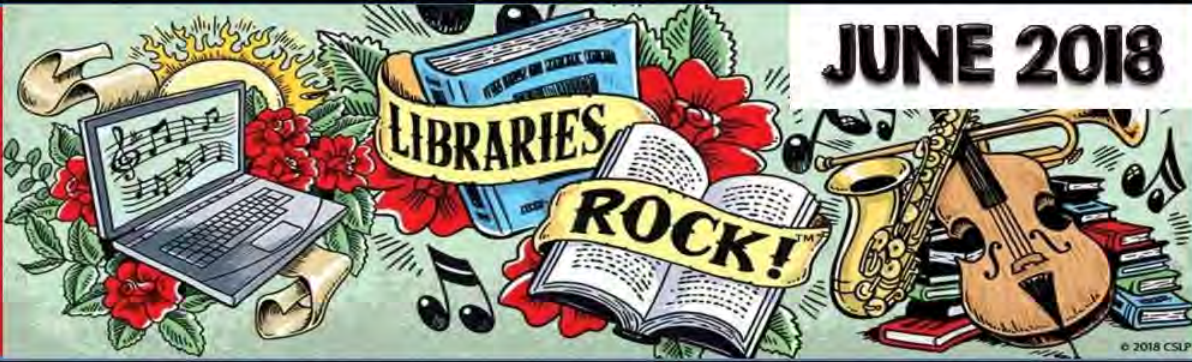
Explore the worlds of music and geology this summer at the New Carlisle Public Library.
