Bethel High School Principal's Update 5-1-20

- Plans for the 2020 Graduation ceremony have been finalized. We have to follow the order of no more than 10 people being able to gather. The following is what is planned:
 - 1. Each Senior will be signing up for a ten minute time slot.
 - 2. A link to Signup Genius has been emailed, and placed on the district website
 - 3. Students can bring up to seven(7) people with them.
 - 4. Park in the back of the school and enter through the Hive entrance.
 - 5. Seniors will walk across the stage of Bethel Hall, have their name announced, and will be presented their diploma by the parent(s)/sibling/etc. of their choosing.
 - 6. There will be plenty of opportunity for parents to take pictures.
 - 7. We will video each Senior, the speeches, and any music.
 - 8. We will put it all together, along with the Senior Slideshow, and will "broadcast" it on the district's Youtube channel at 3:00pm on Saturday, May 23rd.
 - 9. At 6:00pm on Saturday, May 23rd we would invite all Seniors to come to the school and line up in their cars (if a senior doesn't drive, a family member can drive them). We will have a school bus and hopefully a couple of Sheriff Deputies escort the seniors on a predetermined route (route TBD) through the district so that family, friends, and community members can cheer and wave from the side of the road and from their front porches.

While this does not honor the class of 2020 in a typical way, it does allow each senior to walk, be presented their diploma, and have the community recognize them.

- Seniors are reminded that all fees must be paid by graduation in order to receive your diploma and participate in the graduation ceremony.
