June/July/August - The class of 2017 should continue the college application process by visiting college campuses and narrowing choices to at least three colleges/universities for application. Choice one is the student's dream school, choice two is the student's college at which acceptance is probable, and choice three is the school at which the student can be assured of acceptance. Application forms may be submitted as early as August 1 for some colleges. Students who complete forms early have the best opportunity to take advantage of college options such as scholarships and housing. Forms should be completed in their entirety by October 1, 2016, for the 2016/2017 academic year.

June/July/August - High school students are reminded of the summer reading requirement for Literature Survey 9, American Literature 10, English Literature 11, and World Literature 12. These are the honors level English courses at Bethel High School and require summer reading. During the first week of school in August, the students will be tested on the reading material. Students should be prepared for both objective and essay evaluation. The works may be purchased or checked out at local libraries.
